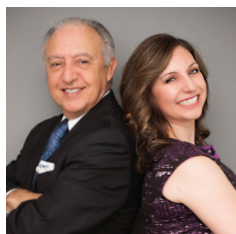

TikTok Facing Lawsuits After Allegedly Collecting Children's Data



A seemingly innocent video-sharing app is being accused of sending to China information on the kids who use it and parents are not happy. Families across the country have filed lawsuits against TikTok, a social media platform owned by the Chinese company ByteDance that allows users to make and share short videos typically set to music. The lawsuits allege that TikTok collects from minors:

- Facial recognition data
- Location data
- Information on close contacts

This data is then allegedly sent to servers in China without parental consent where it is purportedly managed by 3rd party companies that cooperate with the Chinese government.

The lawsuits have been consolidated into one suit that is presided by Judge John Z. Lee in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. The Biometric Information Privacy Act in Illinois requires that technology companies receive written consent before collecting data on a person's identity. It was the same privacy act

that was behind the lawsuit that forced Facebook to agree to pay out a \$650 million settlement regarding their use of facial recognition technology.

According to Forbes, attorneys are requesting that the lawsuit be expanded nationwide as a class action suit, which would open the opportunity for tens of millions of TikTok users to sue.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Egg Roll In A Bowl

Love the taste of egg rolls but don't love that they are deep fried and hard to make? Egg Roll in a Bowl gives you all of the awesome flavors without all the guilt. Plus they're made using only one pan, so the cleanup is a breeze!

INGREDIENTS

- 1 lb (16 oz) ground pork or beef
- 1/2 sweet onion, sliced
- 1 teaspoon minced garlic
- 14 oz shredded cabbage or coleslaw mix
- 1/4 cup low-sodium soy sauce
- 1 teaspoon ground ginger
- 2 teaspoons sriracha
- 1 egg
- 1 Tablespoon sesame oil
- 2 Tablespoons sliced green onion
- 1/2 cup salted cashews

DIRECTIONS

1. In a large, deep skillet or wok, brown the pork or beef with the onions until the meat is no longer pink and the onions are translucent. Add the garlic and sauté for 30 seconds. Add the cabbage/coleslaw, soy sauce, ginger, and sauté until desired tenderness. You can add a little water if you need more liquid to sauté the coleslaw down.
2. Make a well in the center of the skillet and add the egg. Scramble until done over low heat.
3. Stir in sriracha. Drizzle with sesame oil and sprinkle with green onions. Add additional soy sauce and sriracha if desired.
4. Divide into four bowls and top with cashews immediately before serving.
