Thanksgiving leftovers make for awesome weekend fare with these easy and delicious appetizers!

Thanksgiving Leftover Sliders with Stuffing-Stuffed Mushrooms

INGREDIENTS Sliders

- 1 ¹/₄ cups leftover gravy
- 1 74 cups leftover gravy
 2 cups shredded, leftover turkey
- 2 cups shredded, lenover turkey
 One 12-pack pull-apart dinner rolls (like King's Hawaiian)
- One 12-pack pull-apart e
 2 cups leftover stuffing
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup leftover cranberry sauce
- 1 heaping cup leftover mashed potatoes, warmed
- 6 slices provolone
- 1 tablespoon butter, melted
- Flaky sea salt, for sprinkling

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 375° F. Mix together gravy and turkey, warm over the stovetop or in the microwave until the gravy is hot and bubbling.

2. Split dinner rolls horizontally, keeping them attached. Place the top and bottom halves cut-side up on a baking sheet. On one half, spread with cranberry sauce. On the other half, layer stuffing, mashed potatoes, and turkey mixture. Top with provolone.

3. Cover bottom half with top half, brush the tops with melted butter, and sprinkle with sea salt. Bake until bread is toasted, and cheese is melted, 10 to 12 minutes.





*Stuffing-Stuffed Mushrooms*1 cup leftover stuffing

- ¹/₂ cup grated parmesan cheese, divided
- \blacksquare ¹/₄ cup shredded provolone cheese
- 3 Tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 24 button mushroom caps

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 375°F. Mix together stuffing, ¹/₄ cup parmesan, provolone, 2 Tablespoons olive oil, and garlic. Stuff into mushroom caps.

2. Top with remaining parmesan and olive oil. Bake 20 to 25 minutes on a parchment-lined baking sheet.
